








Purpose of the Graduate School




Ordinance on Obtaining a Doctoral Degree at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences of the University of Zurich



➤ Doctoral Program Regulation for the Conferral of Doctorates at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences of the University of Zurich

= "Doktoratsordnung"



- Maximum duration: 6 years (also for part-time)
 - ➤ Begin: with admission to doctorate
 - ➤ End: with award of the degree → the dissertation must be published within the six years
- Recommendation: plan for four years
- Timetable for the main milestones in the Doctoral Agreement



- > Annual Career Discussion with your principal supervisor
- ➤ Doctoral Agreement = record of the Career Discussion
- > Career Discussion and Doctoral Agreement
 - ➤ help to plan the doctorate
 - Serve as basis for a justified termination of the doctorate if it cannot be successfully completed
- For doctoral candidates employed in a qualification position at PhF: The Career Discussion and Doctoral Agreement replace the performance appraisals.



 - > Can be indicated in Doctoral Agreement
 - official confirmation necessary


