
Submit Expert Report and Revision Requirements

You can submit expert reports and revision requirements via Online Services PhD:

- UZH members log in with their Switch-Edu-ID login.
- Members of another Swiss university: Please select your home university as organization in the dropdown menu and enter your usual password.
- Login for members of a foreign university:
 - One-time creation "Switch-edu-ID" at <https://eduid.ch/web/registration/1/?lang=en>
 - Login Online Services PhD: Go to <https://www.phil.uzh.ch/en/studies/doctorate/onlineservices.htm> and scroll down the dropdown menu almost to the end and select "Switch-Edu-ID" as the organization (not UZH or your home institution). Now use the email address and password for login that you used to create the edu-ID in step 1.

Mandatory revision requirements or recommendations for the completion of the doctoral procedure

A distinction must be made between a) revision requirements, which must be incorporated before the dissertation is published in the Zurich Open Repository Archive (ZORA), and b) recommendations for revisions, which are not mandatory. Both variants are optional; you can submit the expert report without revision requirements or recommendations. Without revision requirements, the dissertation can be published directly on ZORA after passing the doctoral examination.

a) Mandatory revision requirements

Please enter in the text field below which revision requirements must be incorporated before the dissertation can be published. Please leave the field blank if you are not imposing any revision requirements.

Important:

- If the dissertation is assessed with at least a grade 4 and thus accepted, revision requirements can only be imposed to a very limited extent.
- The revision has no influence on the grade/predicate of the dissertation.
- Revision requirements must be incorporated and approved by the doctoral committee before the dissertation is published.
